HOW TO DESTROY AMERICA

At an October 2003, immigration-overpopulation conference in Washington, D.C former Colorado Governor Richard D. Lamm stood up and gave a stunning speech on how to destroy America, outlining the eight methods for destruction of the United States. This is an edited version of the article written by Frosty Wooldrige who was in the audience. Follow the link at the end of this piece to read the entire article.

Governor Lamm said: "If you believe that America is too smug, too self-satisfied, too rich, then let's destroy America. It is not that hard to do. No nation in history has survived the ravages of time. Arnold Toynbee observed that all great civilizations rise and fall, and that, 'An autopsy of history would show that all great nations commit suicide.'

"Here is how they do it," Lamm said.

1. "Turn America into a bilingual or multi-lingual and bicultural country. History shows that no nation can survive the tension, conflict and antagonism of two or more competing languages and cultures. It is a blessing for an individual to be bilingual; however; it is a curse for a society to be bilingual.

2. Lamm went on, "Invent 'multiculturalism' and encourage immigrants to maintain their own culture. I would make it an article of belief that all cultures are equal. That there are no cultural differences. I would make it an article of faith that the Black and Hispanic dropout rates are due to prejudice and discrimination by the majority. Every other explanation is out of bounds."

3. Lamm said, "I would encourage all immigrants to keep their own language and culture. I would replace the melting pot metaphor with the salad bowl metaphor. It is important to ensure that we have various cultural sub-groups living in America reinforcing their differences rather than as Americans, emphasizing their similarities.

4. Fourth, I would make our fastest growing demographic group the least educated. I would add a second underclass, unassimilated, undereducated and antagonistic to our population. I would have this second underclass have a 50 percent dropout rate from high school."

5. "My fifth point for destroying America would be to get big foundations and business to give these efforts lots of money. I would invest in ethnic identity, and I would establish the cult of 'Victimology'. I would get all minorities to think their lack of

success was the fault of the majority. I would start a grievance industry blaming all minority failure on the majority population."

6. "My sixth plan for America's downfall would include dual citizenship and promote divided loyalties. I would celebrate diversity over unity. I would stress differences rather than similarities. Diverse people worldwide are mostly engaged in hating each other - that is, when they are not killing each other. A diverse, peaceful or stable society is against most historical precedent.

7. "Having made America a bilingual -- bicultural country, having established multiculturalism, having the large foundations fund the doctrine of 'Victimology,' I would next make it impossible to enforce our immigration laws.

8. "Lastly, I would censor Victor Hanson Davis's book Mexifornia. His book is dangerous. It exposes the plan to destroy America. If you feel America deserves to be destroyed, don't read that book."

THE United Kingdom is our crucial military ally. Australia, with its feisty love of liberty and strategic location, grows more important to us every day. Canada treasures the role of abused spouse. But no country is more important to our future than Mexico.

TAXPAYER BILL OF RIGHTS

TABOR - an acronym for **T**axpayers **B**ill **O**f **R**ights - is a proposed amendment to Nevada's Constitution that would end this last decade's wild expansion of Nevada's government spending. Under TABOR, citizens say "enough is enough" by constraining future government growth to an annual increase equal to population growth plus inflation.

Under TABOR, if any government agency's revenue exceeds the prior year's revenue by more than population growth and inflation, the excess is refunded back to taxpayers.

This is not an original idea. Colorado voters amended their Constitution for TABOR twelve years ago; since then, over \$3-billion has been refunded. More importantly, over \$3-billion wasn't spent hiring more government employee managers to fuel tomorrow's budget shortfall.
