Kenneth Walther, to Speak at Luncheon

Kenneth W. Walther is the CEO of NTCG, Inc. a technology design company engaged in the engineering of wireless homeland security products. In his past, Ken worked as an undercover Technical Operations Officer for the Central Intelligence Agency for 27 years. Primarily in the Directorate of Science and Technology (DS&T), and also in the Directorate of Operations (DO) and the Directorate of Administration (DA). Prior to the Agency Ken served four years in the Army Security Agency (ASA) with three years in Southeast Asia involved with tactical SIGINT collection, e.g. Radio Finger printing and Radio Direction Finding.

During his career with the CIA, Ken spent seventeen years serving on over-

seas assignments and his work led him to visit 101 countries. Twenty years of experience overseas, with the CIA and military, allowed Ken to experience a variety of cultures, languages and operational activities. He built many relationships

Ken retains some fluency in French, Spanish with conversational familiarity in Mandarin, Thai, German, Swedish, and Swahili.

Prior to his government retirement, Ken was a Senior Instructor at an Agency training facility working for the Office of Training and Education. Students included both Agency recruits and military from the Defense Intelligicy. At retirement,



the Agency allowed Ken to retire "open" and his cover was rolled back. He was allowed to accept awards that had been previously locked away because of his cover status. He was awarded the Intelligence Medal of Merit for conducting operations of high national security value as well as the Career Intelligence Medal. He also had numerous certificates from the Department of State and DIA.

Contrasting ——— Constitutions

Recent directives from Mexican President Calderon increasing the funding for Mexican Consulates in the US prompt this exercise in contrasting the United States Constitution with the Mexican Constitution.

An abbreviated version of our US Constitution as applied to the basic requirement for citizenship clearly spells out that all persons born or naturalized in the US are citizens. In 1868 the 14th amendment to the Constitution further clarified the citizenship of those born in the US. Certain resident and procedural requirements are spelled out for those who would be eligible for naturalization.

Any person eligible to become a US citizen must (1) obtain lawful entry to the US and establish permanent residence, (2) make formal declaration before a clerk of the court authorized to naturalize persons, (3) reside continuously at least 5 years in the US, (4) file his petition not less than two or more than 10 years after his declaration of intention, (5) submit to a preliminary hearing, (6) wait at least 90 days after filing before his final hearing when (7) he must attend a hearing and answer such questions as the judge puts to him. Among the requirements the applicant must (1) be able to speak English, (2) not be an anarchist etc. As our country matured there have been a series of modifications of these basic eligibility qualifications. Until these requirements are met an individual is considered an alien whose allegiance is owed to some other country than that in which they reside. Requirements for Mexican citizenship are somewhat similar.

In contrast to the United States Constitution we find that the Mexican Constitution immediately declares that it is a felony to be an illegal alien in Mexico. A basic in Mexican Immigration law declares that foreigners are banned from interfering in the country's internal politics. Foreign visitors who enter Mexico under false pretenses are imprisoned or deported. The Mexican Constitution "General Law on Population" details the country's immigration policy. Mexico welcomes only foreigners who will be useful to Mexican society according to the possibility of contributing to national progress (Article 32), they must have the necessary funds for their sustenance and for their dependents (Article 34) Mexican authorities must keep track of every single person in the country, federal and local and municipal police must cooperate with federal authorities upon request, a national registry keeps track of every individual and verifies each identity (Article 85 & 86), foreigners with fake papers or who entered under false pretenses may be imprisoned or fined (article 116), Foreigners who are deported and attempt to reenter without authorization may be imprisoned for up to 10 years (Article 118). There are considerably more restrictions and reservations detailed in numerous additional articles contained in the Mexican Constitution.

□ This brief partial detail of the US Constitution and the Mexican Constitution clearly illustrates the obvious contrast between both especially as they approach the issue of illegal aliens. Perhaps some of the elements of the Mexican Constitution would be appropriate for application to the illegal aliens entering our United States.
