Sharron Angle was born in Klamath Falls, Oregon on July 26, 1949. Sharron, her parents and her three younger brothers moved to Reno, Nevada after her father's Navy discharge where they owned and operated a small motel for over 20 years. Sharron Angle graduated from Wooster High School in Reno. Four years later, she earned her BA in Fine Arts from the University of Nevada Reno. While a senior at University of Nevada Reno, Sharron married Ted Angle. Sharron and Ted have two children and ten grandchildren.

Sharron was first elected in 1990 to the Nye County School Board of Trustees. The family moved back to Reno in 1995 and in 1998 she was elected to the Nevada State Assembly where she faithfully served until

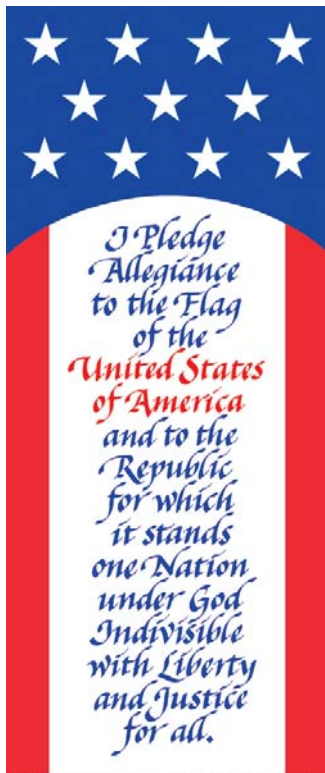

2006 fighting for smaller government, lower taxes, and a better Nevada for future generations. She is proud of her past chairmanship of We the People Nevada PAC that sponsored the Property Tax Restraint Initiative.

A true protector of the Nevada Constitution, Sharron has fought and won judicial battles to protect Nevadan's constitutional rights. In 2003 while serving as the Minority Whip in the Nevada State Assembly, Sharron challenged the Governor's proposed massive \$800 million tax hike. Supported by Nevada's constitutional requirement that all tax increases be approved by a two-thirds super majority, battle lines were drawn between the Republicans in the Assembly and the Governor. Sharron and fourteen other courageous Republicans consistently voted against the tax measure through the end of the regular session of the legislature and on through two special sessions. The Governor then sued the legislature in *Angle v Guinn* to force a decision by the Nevada Supreme Court. The Court over-ruled the two-thirds requirement which meant the taxes were to be imposed through a simple majority rather than by two-thirds vote. Using her own funds, Sharron hired Dr. John Eastman of the Claremont Institute to defend the Nevada's Constitution against this injury. Angle and Eastman took this case to Federal District Court in Nevada, which ended up referring the case to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals, then finally to the U.S. Supreme Court.

The attention from *Angle v Guinn* resulted in the members of the Nevada Supreme Court which made that ruling either retired or were replaced through election defeat. Subsequently the new Court reversed the decision in 2007 reinstating the two-thirds requirement in the Constitution. In recognition of her fight to protect the Constitution, Sharron received the prestigious Claremont Institute Ronald Reagan Freedom Medallion for Courageous Client in 2004.

Though this was a personally costly case for Sharron to defend, this is precisely what she believes the founding fathers meant when they said we must "pledge our lives, our fortunes and our sacred honor" to protect our freedom and liberty.

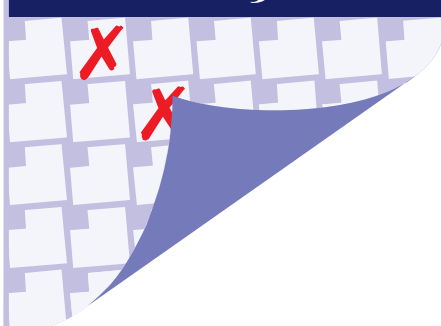

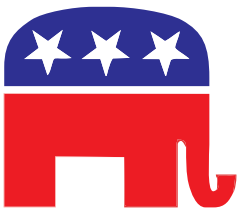

Real Border Enforcement Effort

Perhaps a novel approach to effectively secure our US Southern Borders may result in a positive conclusion. The deployment of adequate forces would accomplish this miracle.

In the closing months of World War 11, I was encased in a column of US troops specifically know as “The Hellcats”, the 12th Armored Division driving towards Berlin. At times we were delayed as we waited for the Russians to advance. Occasionally the delay was due to enemy fire which caused us to temporarily regroup before progressing.

Eventually we arrived liberating some POW camps as we progressed. The obvious question raised is what has this to do with our attempts to seal our US southern borders. If this US 12th Armored Division was effective in contributing to the conclusion of World War 11, perhaps a segment of these “Hellcats” may be assigned to secure our southern borders. As part of this process the Corp of Engineers, a branch of the 12th armored division could be utilized to complete the partially erected border fence. These engineers demonstrated on many occasions that building bridges etc was almost a routine task. Understanding that this would be a costly effort we measure that cost with numerous costly endeavors the US is currently involved with throughout the world. Volumes could be written to list the extensive deployment of US troops.

Many will say that this is a simplistic solution to accomplish border security. We need only to glance at the areas of the world where hostilities have ceased and note that in many areas a presence of US forces accomplishes a measure of security. A token force of 1200 National Guardsmen dispatched to the border with questionable duties will not solve the border problem. Dispatching a proper and substantial force of trained US Army Forces seems to be what is needed for a truly effective border security. This historic endeavor affords us the opportunity to effectively utilize our highly trained and well qualified US Army.
